Seasonal Flights Terminal Building



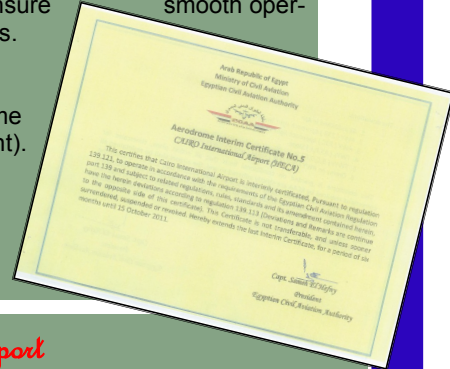
Pilot Hassan Rashed is personally monitoring the progress on construction of Seasonal Terminal Building which underlines its outstanding importance.

New Mini Pumper vehicles for fire fighting

CAC purchased two fully equipped Fire vehicles Ford F550 to support in all landside emergencies. CAC Civil Defense department will use these vehicles stationed at new Landside Fire Station beside existing equipment. The vehicles contains important specialized tools like Hydraulic Power Units to support in vehicles accidents also pneumatic high-pressure lifting bags, chain caws, etc.. With this equipment, Civil Defense Department will be able to support in an absolute professional manner and will operate state-of-the-art equipment.



Automatic People Mover APM

APM will be integrated into and amend the airport's infrastructure after couple of months to ensure short transit times also between Terminals, reduce walking distances for passengers and apply more flexibility for parking the vehicle before getting the travel experience. The new APM will be a high-performance, cost-effective solution for passenger transportation and complete standards modes like shuttle bus or private car. Each train consist of 3 vehicles . 2 of them are dedicated only to Landside, the third is dedicated to Airside-Passengers.

Multi-Storey Car Park MSCP

The Multi Storey Car Park (MSCP) will accommodate more than 3000 cars for passengers, visitors and airlines. MSCP comprises six stories, in a total area of 96000 sqm. MSCP is connected to Automated People Mover as well as to Cairo Airport's Shuttle Bus. Hence all, Employees, Airline Employees, Passengers and Employees of Authorities will be able to use that facility and experience higher safety and customer service. IT supports to indicate empty or filled parking lots so that searching time as known from local car parks will be reduced to minimum.
